

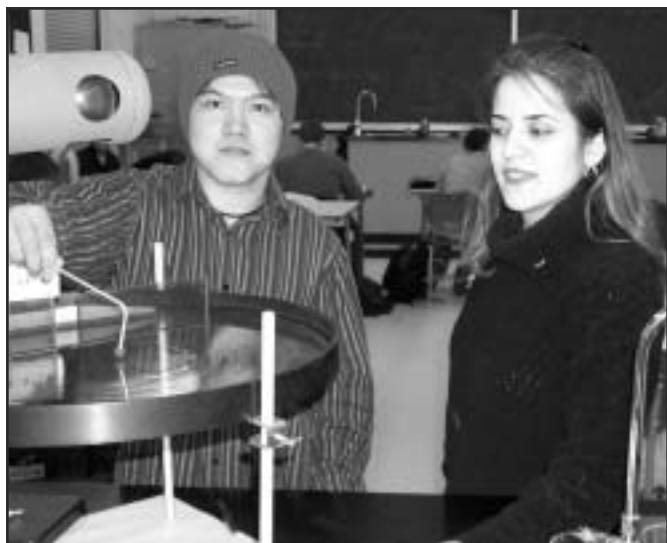


# The Credit Program

The **Continuing Education Credit Programs** offer full credit courses to adults and day school students. Courses of various grade levels, subject areas and types are offered.

The Credit Programs provide an opportunity for day-school students to supplement and enrich their secondary education by acquiring additional credits. These credits may not be available in the student's day school or the student was unable to schedule the course into her/his timetable. Continuing Education credit programs also serve students who were not successful in obtaining a credit, or who passed but want to improve their mark.

Adults, not attending day school, may complete their diploma requirements, upgrade skills and qualifications or obtain a necessary university/college program prerequisite.



## Credit Night School Program

The Credit Night School program offers two semesters; the fall semester runs from September to December, the winter semester from February to May. Classes are held 2 nights per week from 6:10 – 10:01pm each night.

## Credit Summer School Program

The Summer School Credit Program offers Make Up and Reach Ahead courses during the month of July.

## Cooperative Education Summer Program

Summer coop is a work education program for which students receive one credit linked to a course they have previously completed. The course consists of a classroom component and a supervised learning and training placement in the community.
