



# Extra Curricular Creative Arts

The **Extra Curricular Creative Arts Program (ECCA)** is a skill-building instruction program offering foundation and specific arts instructional courses to elementary and intermediate school age children. Programs are established in elementary and intermediate schools where there is sufficient and suitable school space available, available qualified instructors, and sufficient student registration. Interested students may be prepared for the Kiwanis Music Festival; interested and eligible students are prepared for formal examinations in Royal Conservatory of Music (RCM) Performance examinations. The program is a fee-for-service program.

Classes are held outside of school hours (e.g. noon hour, and after school). Classes run throughout the school year from the last week in September to the last week in May (typically for 32 weeks). As well shorter and pilot programs are available during the school year.

## Who can participate in the Extra Curricular Creative Arts Program?

All elementary/intermediate school- aged students, from all schools, from all School Boards.

## Class size, length, fees

Classes are structured in large groups/ensembles, small group (three or four students), Semi-Private (two students), and Individual lessons. Course descriptions indicate class types offered, class size minimum/maximum, class duration and course fee.

## Camps

Recently we have been offering a March Break Camp as well as a four-week Summer Camp—Journey with the Arts.

## Where are courses running?

In Ottawa-Carleton District School Board elementary schools where there is established community interest, and where there is suitable space, a qualified instructor, and sufficient registration. All locations are available to all students. Currently the Program runs at the following sites:
